**REVIEW OF MINUTES**

1. Wastewater Update 7/9/2024 City Attorney – Bryan is working with a consortium to locate a wastewater specialist
2. FEMA Update - Tracking Damages – Ty, Michelle, and Sam are working together to create a spreadsheet of all losses for submission to the State and FEMA
3. City Charter Changes – Referendum - Tanya Johnson from the City charter commission discussed progress and need for Bryan to finish Section 12.18 and then advance it to a Public Meeting on 7-16. Mike will post this, and we hope to have this ready for the Council work session on 7-23. We will need to have this to the County by 8-24 to have it placed on the referendum.
4. MP Switchgear Update – This has been delayed due to all the storms and Sam is setting it up and will inform us of a date.
5. Retaining Wall Update – The Council does not want to support this claim and set a “past practice” of repairing walls for private citizens. The one that was cited as having been done previously was part of a larger scale road project and not for a private citizen.
6. Miscellaneous items
7. Firewood Contract – This contract will be terminated because of a conflict with Paul Skrbec running for Council and he and the City will still work together to coordinate shipping.
8. Flood – Garbage Bill – The Council is not going to support paying flood clean-up bills that were generated before they decided to provide pick up for residents affected by the flood.
9. Mangey Invoice 36K – We discussed this one be included in payments.

10. Inspection Fees for Septic/Wastewater hook up – The City will pay the inspector directly and get the money back from the affected properties.
