The Gilbert Police Department is accepting applications and resume for the position of full-time police officer. Applicants must meet MN POST qualifications to be licensed.

Ability to successfully complete: Oral Evaluation, Background Investigation, Psychological, Physical and Drug Screening.

Lateral entry will be accommodated to qualified candidates.

The Gilbert Police Department provides police services for the cities of Gilbert and Biwabik which includes the Giant's Ridge Recreation Area. The Gilbert Police Department consists of 7 full-time officers and one administrative assistant.

The Gilbert Police Department is very unique as it is home to Minnesota's First Off-Highway Vehicle Park. This creates opportunities to patrol on ATV and On/Off Roadway Motorcycle. Officers are also allowed to alpine ski on duty during events at the Giant's Ridge Ski Resort. The two cities have approximately 22 square miles of patrol area.

Benefits:

- Health Insurance: 90/10 premium coverage, deductible is fully covered by the city
- Sunday Premium Pay (extra 1/2 time pay on Sundays)
- Longevity Pay Vacation: 48-288 Hours/Year
- Sick Leave: Approximately 120 Hours/Year
- Personal Leave: 36 Hours/Year
- After 25 years of service, the City of Gilbert provides retiree officers with the same hospital and medical coverage as active city employees.

Officers work a rotating 4 on 4 off 12 hour schedule.
